作为由社区创办、并长期得到社区支持的非营利教育机构，中文学校在传播中华语言与文化的同时，也希望为学生提供参与社区建设、服务他人和锻炼领导能力的机会。

学生助教(Teaching Assistant, 简称 TA)项目正是基于这一理念而设立。通过协助教师开展教学活动、帮助低年级同学成长、参与学校活动组织与社区服务，学生不仅能够回馈学校和社区，也能够真实的实践环境中培养组织能力、合作能力、解决问题的能力以及领导力。

对于许多学生而言，TA 项目不仅是一段志愿服务经历，更是一次从参与者成长为贡献者、从学习者成长为领导者的重要历程。

TA 项目发展路径

Student TA

学生可在九年级或十年级申请加入 TA 项目，在老师指导下参与课堂辅助、活动支持以及学生服务工作。

Head TA

学校将根据学生的服务表现、责任感、团队合作精神和领导潜力，从优秀 TA 中选拔 Head TA，协助协调 TA 团队工作，并承担更多组织职责。

Principal Assistant

学校将从 Head TA 中进一步选拔 Principal Assistant，参与学校大型活动筹划、学生志愿者管理以及项目协调工作，在更高层面服务学校和社区。

项目收获

参与 TA 项目的学生将有机会：

- 服务社区，培养社会责任感；
- 传承中华文化，增强文化认同感；
- 提升沟通、组织与团队合作能力；
- 获得真实的领导力实践经验；
- 建立服务精神与公益意识；
- 为未来大学申请、奖学金申请及职业发展积累有价值的经历。

申请与选拔

学校通常于每年七月至八月期间在官方网站开放 TA 项目申请。欢迎有责任感、乐于服务社区、愿意帮助他人成长，并希望提升领导力与组织能力的学生积极申请。学校将根据申请材料、过往表现以及岗位需求进行综合评估与选拔。

Dean's Scholarship

Wellesley Chinese School has always believed that education is not only about imparting knowledge, but also about cultivating a sense of responsibility, a spirit of service, and leadership skills.

As a non-profit educational institution founded by the community and supported by the community for a long time, the Chinese School, while spreading the Chinese language and culture, also hopes to provide students with opportunities to participate in community building, serve others, and develop leadership skills.

We believe that true leadership does not come from titles, but is gradually formed through the process of serving others, responsibility awareness, communication skills, and teamwork spirit.

The Student Teaching Assistant (TA) program is established based on this concept. By assisting teachers in conducting teaching activities, helping lower-grade students grow, participating in school activity organization and community services, students can not only give back to the school and the community, but also cultivate organizational skills, cooperation skills, problem-solving skills, and leadership in a real practical environment.

For many students, the TA program is not only a volunteer experience, but also an important journey from being a participant to becoming a contributor, from a learner to a leader.

The development path of the TA project

Student TA

Students can apply to join the TA program in either the ninth grade or the tenth grade. Under the guidance of teachers, they can participate in classroom assistance, activity support, and student services.

Head TA

The school will select the Head TA from among the outstanding TAs based on their service performance, sense of responsibility, teamwork spirit and leadership potential. The Head TA will assist in coordinating the work of the TA team and undertake additional organizational responsibilities.

Principal Assistant

The school will further select Principal Assistants from the Head TAs to participate in the planning of major school events, the management of student volunteers, and project coordination, thus providing higher-level services to the school and the community.

Project Benefits

Students participating in the TA project will have the opportunity to:

- Serve the community and cultivate a sense of social responsibility;
- Inherit Chinese culture and enhance cultural identity;
- Improve communication, organization and teamwork skills;
- Gain real leadership experience;
- Establish a spirit of service and a sense of public welfare;
- Accumulate valuable experiences for future university applications, scholarship applications and career development.

Application and Selection

The school usually opens the application for the TA program on its official website from July to August each year. Students who are responsible, willing to serve the community, eager to help others grow, and aspire to enhance their leadership and organizational skills are encouraged to apply actively. The school will conduct a comprehensive assessment and selection based on the application materials, past performance, and job requirements.

Dean's Scholarship

Students who serve as TA in the Chinese language school and meet the relevant conditions can apply for the Dean's Scholarship. The approved students will receive the corresponding rewards (for specific requirements, please refer to the Dean's Scholarship application instructions).
